

2017-2018 HCC DISASTER RELIEF PROJECT PLAN

SCOPE OF COMMITTEE – To coordinate all efforts by Houston City Council to obtain disaster relief for HCC sisters and/or all Beta Sigma Phi sisters, keeping in mind that donations from HCC sisters and others toward this effort are totally voluntary.

The HCC Disaster Relief Project is in addition to the 2017-2018 HCC Service Project Fallen Warriors which is coordinated by the HCC Service Committee. (Proven successful for HCC during the Louisiana crisis about 2 years ago that HCC can do both projects simultaneously).

PLAN FOR DONATION OF GOODS

- 1) Contact all HCC sisters affected by the current disaster and obtain a list of their current needs.
- 2) Send International's Disaster Relief Fund Application by email to all sisters affected and ask them to submit it to International as soon as possible before funds are depleted if they feel that they need assistance from this fund.
- 3) Send an email blast to all HCC sisters with a list of current needs and ask them to bring any items on the list that they wish to donate to designated Houston City Council Meeting or Meetings.
- 4) Develop plans for pickup and delivery for all goods donated.

REPEAT STEPS 1-4 AS LONG AS NEEDED

PLAN FOR DONATION OF MONEY TO INTERNATIONAL DISASTER RELIEF FUND

- 1) All donations for those who wish to donate to the International Disaster Relief Fund through Houston City Council should be submitted in the name of Houston City Council.
- 2) These donations can be from individual members of HCC or from HCC chapters.
- 3) Set a deadline for monetary donations to be submitted to HCC by the November HCC Meeting. All donations are to be submitted to the HCC Treasurer at the end of the November meeting. The Treasurer will then send one check to International.
- 4) Due to the pleas on Beta Sigma Phi Facebook from sisters in other states that are experiencing disasters (e.g., forest fires, flooding, earthquakes, tornados, etc.) asking us to not forget them, the HCC Board recommends that our sisterly aim should be to help rebuild this fund for all sisters in need and not designate any donation from our council sisters to a certain area. This recommendation will be voted on by membership at the September HCC Meeting.
